




#### WHO'S WHO

GEORGE EASTMAN (Playwright) After seeing two plays on Broadway that his uncle Carroll Moore had written (Make A Million and Send Me No Flowers), George Eastman decided he wanted to be a writer. His first full-length play, The Snow Job, was published by Samuel French and has been produced in several community theaters throughout the country. His next play, Lost In The Field, was produced at the Northampton Center For The Arts. His one-act play, Bitter Exchange, won a performance at the New Works Play Festival in Pittsburgh. When he retired after four decades of teaching French to fidgety eighthgraders, he enjoyed his restored energy and wrote his first novel, The Penelope Peters Effect, and he is currently shopping it for representation. After winning several short fiction contests in Western Massachusetts, his wife convinced him to turn one of the stories, Harry Townsend's Last Stand, into a play. It was recently given a staged reading by the American Theatre Group at the SOPAC and starred Len Cariou and Warren Bub, and was directed by Dennis Grimaldi. He is now working on three other full-length plays: Last Call, about the strength and weakness of old friendships in the last politically incorrect bar in town - Molly and Max, about a snappy old coot and a sparkling old cootette who fall in love in cautious steps, and Creature Comforts, about three old codgers by a fire-pit who try to sum up their lives before they die. Mr. Eastman lives on Cape Cod with his wife Susan.








